Tip of the Month

The water is getting extremely warm, so here are a couple ideas to deal with the sweltering heat of midsummer fishing. First, fishing deeper water areas is never a bad idea in the good old summertime. Another option is to try is dead-sticking a plastic bait. Just throw it out there and let it sit – for as long as you can stand it, or until a fish picks it up.

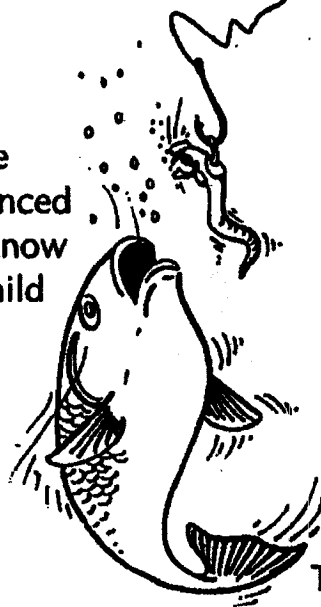
